When on peer support duty:
☐ Give up playing own game for that lunch
☐ Wear vest so you are visible to everyone (teachers, students, parents)
\square Go to the Admin to ask for any jobs that need to be completed
☐ Walk around the WHOLE school (Don't stay in senior area)
☐ Chat to students: get to know them and show that you are friendly and
they can come and talk to you
☐ Support the duty teacher (Say hello to them, let them know you are out
in the playground too)
☐ Situations to help out in:
 Helping students find a friend/ someone to play with
 Small problems with games (Can act as a referee/umpire)
 Referring bigger issues to duty teacher
 Reminding students of school rules/ appropriate behaviours at recess
