BACKGROUND

Students from metropolitan and country areas enrol full time in a comprehensive Netball Program from Year 7-12.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

- Match play – interclass carnivals, specialist netball schools carnivals, High School Cup Interscholar competition and regional carnivals.
- History of Netball.
- Diet and nutrition.
- Sports medicine awareness course.
- Umpiring courses (player's exam).
- Game Analysis – class teams, state league teams and national league teams.
- Player and team psychology (goal setting and team building).
- Guest speaker program.
- Equipment and shoe technology.
- Tours – country and interstate
